## **Instructions for teachers:**

Dear teacher, thank you for booking a visit to Creekside Discovery Centre! To extend your students' learning we have produced some **pre- and post-visit resources**, access to which is included in your session cost.

Creekside Challenge is a pre-visit task for students.
