Place equipment and sit groups on the side of the boardwalk furthest from water's edge or set up 3 tables outside the rear exit of the building and one participant from each group comes onto the boardwalk to pond dip Keep a long handled net accessible for extracting participants from the pond quickly and safely should they fall in Give a demonstration of how to pond dip safely.
